

Scheme (SDIS) for modular Employable Skills Courses approved by NCVT.

Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that this Department has taken steps for imparting training to the Youths throughout the State on different trades in collaboration and assistance with the Department of Technical Education and Training (TE & T), Government of West Bengal. The training courses are approved by NCVT, and the training will be imparted by the professional agencies selected by the Department of TE & T. This will certainly help the Youth to enhance their skill and thereby create opportunities for their Self-Employment.

A list of Sub-division wise training programme with no. of candidates, training courses, duration, Training Agencies, Venue of Training etc. has been chalked out for this purpose. This is to mention that the qualification of candidates will be at least Madhyamik with age between 18 years to 35 years. Batch size will be 20-25 candidates.

During this Financial Year, a total of 2980 Youths will be imparted training in selected trades. For youths having family income less than Rs.1.20 lakh per annum the entire training expenses (which is an average of Rs.16.325/- only) will be borne by this Department and for others, 50% will be borne by this Department and balance 50% will have to be borne by the candidate. An indicative break-up of no. of candidates in both categories district-wise is annexed.

To implement this programme, you are requested to invite applications from the Youths and prepare Sub-division wise list of candidates through a Screening Committee consisting of one Additional District Magistrate, District Youth Officer and one BYO/MYO. The Sub-division wise training programme and model application form is attached herewith. The process of selection of candidates may be completed within 31st July, 2014.
