| 5) Essential Qualifications | : | Shall have a minimum of completed seven years of experience of working with children in the field of education, health, or welfare activities,
OR
Should be a practising professional with a degree in child psychology or psychiatry or social work or sociology or human development or in the field of law
OR
Should be a retired legal or judicial officer. |

All the qualifications and experience must be completed on or before the last date of receiving application.

General information for applicants:

- The term of a Chairman of Child Welfare Committee shall not be more than for a period of 3 (three) years from the date of appointment.
- The Chairman of the Committee shall be eligible for appointment of maximum of 2 (two) terms.
- Scope of work: The Committee shall sit on all working days for a minimum of six hours commensurate with the workings of a Magistrate Court, and for at least 20 days in a month.
- Residence : The candidate must be a resident of the district for which he / she is an applicant.
