

Advertisement for engagement of Part time Homoeopathic Medical Officer (AYUSH) under NRHM

Applications are invited from the citizens of India having requisite eligibility laid down in the table below for engagement to the post of part time Homoeopathic Medical Officer (HMO) under NRHM for the no. 7 Ramchandrapur Gram Panchayat level dispensary under Tapan Development Block in the District.

2	Vacancy	One post at Ramchandrapur Gram Panchayat – Tapan Block
3	Qualification	Post Graduate Degree (MD), A Graduate (BHMS) or a Diploma (DMS/DHMS) in Homoeopathy from an institution recognized by Central Council of Homoeopathy and must be registered with State or Central Council of Homoeopathy.
4	Age	Not more than 50 years on the 1 st January , 2015 , Upper age is relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST & 3 years for OBC
5	Honorarium	The part time Homoeopathic Medical Officer will be given honorarium on daily basis. The rate is at present Rs. 605/- per day basis subject to maximum 20 days in a month.

General Instructions/ Guidelines for the candidates:

1. Application in prescribed format along with attested copy of the mark sheet and other certificates along with the age proof and permanent residential proof will have to be submitted within due period to appropriate authority.
2. Application dully filled up in the prescribed format in the sealed envelope along with the self addressed envelope (10.5x4.5) with postage stamp Rs.5/-affix on it may be deposited by hand or by post to the office of Block Development Officer, Tapan. The receiving officer of the Block Office will issue the receipt in prescribed proforma attached with the application form to the candidate and the candidate will collect the receipt by his /her effort. The receiving officer will make entry in the register as per guideline memo no. 65-SPHC/2M-2/09 dated 22.02.2010
3. The name of the post will have to be clearly mentioned on sealed envelope.
4. A) Applicants within the concern Gram Panchayat will get preference.
B) If no candidate is available from Gram Panchayat then candidates from the Block area shall be considered and selection will be made observing procedure as per guideline.
C) If no candidate is available in the Block area, candidates from the Sub –Division will be considered following the same procedure. Candidates from other area of the district will only be considered in case of non – availability of applicant in the Sub – Division area.
